



Hurricane Re-entry Pass Information

A blue re-entry pass is authorized to homeowners, whether full or part time residents. The re-entry pass authorizes the resident entry into the municipality after the Emergency Management Director has declared it safe for them to do so after a severe storm. This pass authorizes the resident to enter the area before the island is opened to the general public in order to examine their property for storm damage. There is only one free pass issued per residence.

The individual requesting a re-entry pass must present proof of purchase of the property. Closing statements or utility billing statements showing the individual's name and address shall be considered proof of purchase. Individuals must also present a picture ID. Requestors will be asked to provide their full name, spouse's name, address of the property in Pine Knoll Shores, and telephone number. Part time residents will also be asked for their full time mailing and physical addresses and telephone number. Long term renters should bring a copy of their lease agreement and water statement.

Re-entry passes are permanent and do not need to be replaced unless lost or destroyed. The replacement fee is \$25. Please return re-entry passes upon moving. New property owners are requested to let us know the previous owner so that the old pass can be canceled.

Residents are entitled to one free re-entry pass per residence. Any additional re-entry passes are \$25.
